The Liberty Bell Committee has reserved the Emporia Country Club for the annual celebration on Friday, May 1. More information will come from the committee.



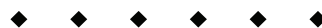

What's a MAC? (and we don't mean Apple computers)

MAC stands for Media Access Control and acts as the unique identifier for a computer, smartphone, printer or other similar device. The law library's wireless network uses WPA/WPA2 security and a database of registered MAC addresses.
